I. Leading High Performing Teams

In this inspiring session we will share lessons from the world of professional cycling about leadership, teamwork, and high performance. A high performing culture is the direct result of effective leadership and the ability of team members to support each other, collaborate and to unite around common purpose.

II. Disciplined Execution

It is not enough to simply develop a vision for success — it is also essential for a vision to be articulated in a strategy that can be executed across all levels of the organization. This session will draw on lessons from the world of elite-level cycle sport to talk about the principles for developing and executing a strategy — from top leadership to front-line workers and support staff. III. Technology & Innovation

In this entertaining and informative keynote talk participants will learn how bicycle technology has evolved over the past thirty years, and how the industry has been shaped by continuous innovation in both materials and business model design. Participants will appreciate the risk of failing to invest in research and development in fast moving industries, and the way in which new entrants can disrupt established players. The talk will be relevant for any company working in technology-based industries — not just cycling related businesses. Participants will not only have a chance to listen to the talk, but also to see and ride classic bicycles from the past three decades.
